- No running or horseplay.
- No glass is allowed in pool area.
- No food or drink in the pool.
- No cut-offs allowed in the water.
- No person with open sores, bandages or any symptom of any communicable disease is allowed in the water.
- All babies/toddlers must wear a swim suit and swim diaper that fits tightly around the legs.
- Pool will close immediately in the event of hazardous weather.
- No Smoking and No Alcohol.
